Youth Project

Marr Area Forum

Group Membership of Marr Area Partnership

- MAP is to become a Company limited by guarantee. They wish to establish a formal membership list. Members present decided on behalf of TDG that group membership should be taken up.

Squirrel Bridge

- WH has obtained permission in principal from the MRT for the rope bridge. He is still waiting to hear from Aberdeenshire Council. The MRT are willing to help with the installation.
- Possible sites are opposite Park House or opposite WH's own gate. Both sites have suitable trees, on both sides of the road, to which the bridge could be attached.
